

Pillars:

- Credible Expertise: Unite former federal/state public health leaders, grassroots practitioners, and those with lived experience to shape national, state, and local strategies.
- Culturally & Community Informed Communications: Design and deliver communications that reflect the values and realities of hardto-reach audiences.
- Science, Strategy & Storytelling: We fuse storytelling, science, and strategy to craft culturally resonant campaigns that inform, inspire, and drive measurable impact.
- Strategic Use of Opioid Settlement Funds: Support jurisdictions in using settlement dollars responsibly for evidence-based prevention, treatment, and harm reduction efforts.

O.U.R Alliance was founded by CMRignite to fill a gap in culturally grounded, expert-led opioid response efforts.

Overdose Prevention



PREVENT OVERDOSE DEATHS

Despite progress, drug overdose deaths continue to impact our nation.

NEARLY 108,000 OVERDOSE DEATHS IN 2022

- The majority involved a prescription or illicit opioid.
- Taking more than one drug at the same time can increase overdose risk.

Not all overdoses have to end in death.



- · Learn about the risks of opioids.
- Learn about naloxone, its availability, and how to use it.
- Help people struggling with substance use disorders find the right care and treatment.



Why This Work Matters Now



The Crisis Persists: Opioid overdose remains one of the leading causes of preventable death in the U.S.—with disproportionate impact on Black, Native, rural, and historically underserved communities.

Unprecedented Funding: States are now receiving billions in opioid settlement dollars—but lack clear, culturally grounded and data-informed strategies for effective distribution and use of funds.

The Moment for SMEs: Federal layoffs have displaced top experts, creating both a gap and an opportunity to continue supporting states with technical assistance with public education..

We're stepping in now to support thoughtful, locally tailored, trauma-informed responses that save lives.



Alliance Key Activities



What We Do



O.U.R. Alliance works to translate vision into action through campaigns, resources, outreach, and media engagement. These activities **elevate SME voices**, **support local leadership**, **and advance health equity outcomes** in opioid response.

Our Key Activities Include:

- Launching public education campaigns that focus on culturally grounded opioid prevention, treatment, and risk reduction.
- Thought Leadership through blog posts, Op-Eds, and white papers, and Op-Eds co-authored by SMEs.
- Providing technical assistance to jurisdictions using opioid settlement funds to drive measurable, community-informed change with toolkits, training materials, and other guidance.
- Hosting webinars and developing media strategies to amplify SME perspectives and evidencebased practices to reach communities across the country.
- Convening a lived experience advisory panel to ensure messaging is validated and community authentic.

Collaboration Framework



How We Work Together



The O.U.R. Alliance is structured to allow for both agility and depth. Our collaboration process ensures lived experience and professional expertise are seamlessly integrated into all deliverables, from community needs assessments, campaign communication strategy development, materials development, and community mobilization.

How We Could Work Together:

- Lived Experience Advisory Panel: Engaged to co-create resources, review campaigns, and validate messaging. SME reviewers are tapped for authenticity checks, culturally competency and iterative feedback on programmatic strategies and public education materials.
- **Operational Contributors:** SMEs and support team members drive cross-sector collaborations and engagement, campaign development, thought leadership, and program development support.
